Environmental Policy

The Tideway Owners Association ("TOA") is an association for owners of the Tideway class sailing dinghy. The TOA has no premises, and is run by a Committee of volunteers. The Committee arranges for a number of meetings each year at various sailing clubs and similar venues around the country, and communicates with members via a website and three Newsletters a year.

The TOA is committed to minimising the impact of its activities on the environment. This policy sets out how the TOA ("we") will work towards achieving its environmental objectives.

- 1. We will meet the environmental legislation relevant to our activities, and, where possible, identify opportunities to adopt best practice over and above the minimum legislative requirements.
- 2. We will seek to minimise pollution and adverse environmental impacts of our activities.
- 3. We will minimise the creation of waste. For example; we will maximise the use of our website and email to communicate with members and within the Committee, with on-line meetings to reduce travel. And we encourage the use of re-cycled paper for our Newsletter.
- 4. We will promote relevant local environmental information to our members attending meetings, such as locations of sensitive habitats or wildlife.
- 5. We will continue to encourage members attending meetings to support organisations looking after the local environment, waters and habitat.
- 6. We will continue to apply a geographical spread of meetings to minimise the need for members to travel long distances.
- 7. We will encourage members to consider using re-chargeable electric outboard motors rather than fossil fuel.
- 8. We will continue to support and encourage members to maintain and renovate their Tideways to pro-long their useful life; to use materials recycled from boats that cannot be restored or from sustainable and environment friendly sources, and re-cycled fittings.
- 9. We will seek to ensure that, wherever possible, our licenced boatbuilders use timber and other materials from sustainable sources for newbuilds and renovation projects.
- 10. We will publicise our environmental commitment and promote sustainability amongst our members via our website and Newsletter.
- 11. We will review this policy annually.
